NEW DEADLINE:

Contributions will be accepted until the **15th November 2014** (for abstracts and full contributions)

Contributions will be accepted in two formats:

Abstracts: Upon acceptance, these contributions will be presented in POSTER format. Abstracts MUST NOT exceed a maximum length of 500 words.

Full contribution: Upon acceptance, these will be presented either in ORAL or POSTER format and will have an extension of between 5 and 10 pages, including text and figures.

Guidelines and templates to preparing and submitting a manuscript are available at the webpage under the section **Presentations – Instructions for authors**.

Official languages: Contributions will be accepted in SPANISH, PORTUGUESE or ENGLISH. The inclusion of a short abstract in English is REQUESTED for all contributions.

Meteorológica magazine offers a 50% discount on the cost of publication of papers from the CONGREMET XII. This offer is valid until June 30, 2015.

Congress Themes

Forecasting in the atmosphere and the oceans: Methodological aspects of forecasting in different time-space scales: Climate change projections. Ensemble forecasting. Predictability studies. Pollutant dispersion forecasting, among others.

Meteorology and Oceanography within the society: Products and applications for society and the productive sector. Educational issues and outreach in meteorology and oceanography. Communication with the public. Governmental programs at national and local levels.

Characterization and processes in the atmosphere and the oceans: Processes in different time-space scales, from the microscale up to planetary processes. Different scales variability.

Observing systems: Development and validation of instruments. Quality control. Measurement network design. Communication and data acquisition. Visualization systems.
