The Argentine Center of Meteorologists is pleased to inform that the XV Argentine Congress of Meteorology will take place from September 30 to October 3, 2025 in the city of La Plata, under the theme "Warning systems for the reduction of socio-environmental impacts: strengthening, integration and challenges".



Thematic Areas

Atmosphere and Ocean Forecast

Methodological aspects of different spatio-temporal scale forecasting: climate change projections, ensemble forecasts, predictability studies, pollutant dispersion forecast, among others. Development and implementation of operational forecasting systems.

Insertion of meteorology and oceanography into society

Products and applications for the population and the productive sector. Education in meteorology and oceanography, university extension and dissemination. Communication to the public. Government programs at the national, state and local levels. Studies on exposure, vulnerability and risk of disasters and/or events of high social impact associated with the atmosphere and the ocean at different spatio-temporal scales.

Atmospheric and Oceanic processes and variability

Study of atmospheric and oceanic processes and variability at different spatio-temporal scales. Interaction between Earth system components (hydrosphere, atmosphere, cryosphere, biosphere and lithosphere).

Acquisition, processing and analysis of environmental data

Technologies for obtaining and processing environmental data (observation systems, high-performance computing systems, instrument development and validation, measurement networks design, communication and data acquisition systems, etc.). Methodologies for environmental data analysis (statistical and numerical, machine learning, visualization, quality control, etc.).

Information for paper submission:

Extended abstracts: Papers will only be accepted in this format. They should have a maximum length of 3 pages including figures and/or tables. Papers may be presented in oral or poster form.

Editing guidelines: Templates with formatting guidelines for extended abstracts will soon be available on the Congress website.

Official languages: Papers may be submitted and presented in Spanish, Portuguese or English. In all cases, the inclusion of an abstract in English will be required.
